



Modern Science: Project Review Sheet

Before we can provide you with a quote for your project, we'll need to learn more about the nature of your work, your goals, and a few technical details.

Bellow, we've included some general questions that will help us understand the ins-and-outs of what you'd like to accomplish and how we can best meet your needs.

It's ok if you can't answer all of these questions completely right now or if some of them aren't applicable - this list is only intended to be a starting point to guide initial discussions.

General Questions

1	What is the overall aim of your research?
2	What is the end-goal for initiating a citizen science project related to your work?
3	What is the nature of the task to be performed by citizen scientists? <i>(e.g. feature identification, shape/size evaluation, field observations, etc.)</i>
4	What type of data will be analyzed or collected by citizen scientists? <i>(e.g. images, video, audio, field observations, etc.)</i>
5	If you have data that will be analyzed, what format is it in? <i>(e.g. jpg, mov, mp3, txt, etc.)</i>
6	Do you have plans for the resulting data product(s) that will be generated by the citizen scientists contributing to your project?

Your Dataset

1	How large is the dataset to be analyzed, if applicable? <i>(e.g. number of photos, file sizes, hours of video, etc.)</i>
2	Is the dataset to be analyzed a fixed size, or will it be added to over time?
3	Where does your dataset currently reside? <i>(e.g. publicly accessible server, intranet, portable hard drives, 3rd-party storage, etc.)</i>
4	Would it be possible to obtain a sample of your data to be analyzed? <i>(e.g. images, video, audio, etc.)</i>



Existing Resources

1	Do you have an existing website or social media accounts for your group / organization?
2	Do you have any materials on-hand that could be included in the project? <i>(e.g. videos, presentations, photos, text, public outreach materials, etc.)</i>
3	Do you work with other personnel who would be contributing to the project? <i>(e.g. lab group members, other researchers, graphic designers, software developers, engineers, media relations, video production, etc.)</i>



Timeframe and Budget

1	Do you have a general project timeframe and/or completion date in mind?
2	Do you envision this project as a multi-year initiative, or something shorter-term?
3	Do you have funding on hand, or are you applying for funds to support the project?
4	Are you currently working under a deadline for this project? <i>(e.g. proposal submission deadline, overall completion date, etc.)</i>
5	What is your budget for this project?
